



Sunset Walk FAQs

Why is this a virtual event?

With the uncertainty of the next few months and having spoken with some of our supporters, we have decided to make this event virtual to ensure that all participants feel comfortable and safe. A physical event would create large crowds and we understand many are still unsure about meeting in bigger groups.

What is meant by 'virtual' event?

By 'virtual' we mean remote. Everyone will be taking part in the walk at the same time but in different places. We ask walkers to pick their own route that feels special to them and invite friends and family to join them. We then ask participants to take a photo of the sunset wherever they are and share it with the hospice. We'll post these all online so that even though we aren't all together, we will be sharing the same sunset.

Can I walk with my friends if I want to?

Of course! You can walk with as many or as few people as you wish.

I don't have access to the internet, can I still take part?

Of course! Internet access is only required if you would like to share your sunset photos, you're more than welcome to take part and walk your special route with loved ones regardless of this.

What happens if restrictions get tightened again?

We are monitoring the situation closely and will be in touch with all participants if this arises. This may require groups to walk separately or the walk to be taken as part of daily exercise.

How much do I have to fundraise?

We ask walkers to try and raise as much as they can. Any donation, big or small, will go a long way to helping us support local families affected by illness, bereavement and grief.

Where do I walk?

That's completely up to you! We'll send some suggestions but you can walk anywhere! Perhaps you have a favourite route you walked with a loved one or there's a particularly good sunset from a hill near you. You can also walk for as long as you would like or just take a few steps to the end of your garden.

How far do I have to walk?

That's completely up to you. Some people like a challenge and plan to walk 10km whilst others prefer to do a shorter stroll.



What do I get in my registration pack?

You will receive a special hospice t-shirt, paper lantern and battery operated candle to take with you on your journey as well as help and support on the best ways to fundraise.

I've registered but can no longer walk on this date, what do I do?

Why not take part in a Sunset Walk on a different day? We'll keep our sunset wall visible for 1 month after the event so you can share your images at any time.
